



## Module 3 Summary: Exploitation and vulnerable situations – What signs am I looking for?

Module 3 extends your knowledge and understanding of safeguarding by informing you of more specific categories of abuse, along with the signs to be looking out for, during your time in school.

- Some categories of abuse such as child-on-child abuse (bullying) and online abuse will be more common in schools compared to other categories of abuse such as 'honour'-based abuse (HBA) or Child Criminal Exploitation (CCE). However, it is important for you to be aware of the different categories of abuse detailed in this module and the signs of them, so that you can carefully monitor the safety of the children around you and be proactive in reporting your concerns if necessary.
- You have also looked at specific situations which can facilitate abuse or increase the vulnerability of the child.
- You have explored two different manipulative situations that pose a danger to the safeguarding of a child through exploitation. They are radicalisation (Prevent Duty) and modern slavery (National Referral Mechanism).
